We would like to let you know Polk County is doing as much as possible to repair roads, culverts, and bridge approaches. The crews are replacing culverts were washed out with new corrugated metal pipe. Due to the age of the culverts, many were rusted out on the bottom so new ones were required, taking extra fill material and time. The County Road Dept. is using mud rock, crushed concrete, asphalt millings and gravel to get roads passable. Grading operations are thusly slowed.

A combination of many snow removals, excessive rain, and quick snow melt caused havoc as everyone knows. Polk County is very fortunate compared to other counties in northern and eastern Nebraska.
