Minutes of the January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 meeting of the Polk County Board of Equalization were read and approved. Chairman Westring informed those in attendance that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

A motion was made by Boruch to open the hearing on the motor vehicle exemptions for the Osceola Good Samaritan Society, the Midwest Covenant Home and Stromsburg Busy Wheels. The motion was seconded by Boss and the roll call vote was Boruch, aye; Boss, aye; Westring, aye. No interested persons appeared. A motion was made by Boss to close the hearing. The motion was seconded by Boruch and all members voted in the affirmative. A motion was made by Boss to approve the motor vehicle exemptions for the 2014 Ford Econoline van, 2016 Dodge Caravan, 1996 Chevrolet S10 pickup, and 2008 Chevrolet Uplander van owned by the Osceola Good Samaritan Society, the 2003 Chevrolet Express van, 2006 Chevrolet Uplander van, 2006 GMC Sierra pickup, 2014 Chrysler van and 2007 Buick Lucerne sedan owned by the Midwest Covenant Home and to approve the motor vehicle exemption for the 1998 Mercury Grand Marquis sedan owned by Stromsburg Busy Wheels. The motion was seconded by Boruch and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Boruch, aye; Westring, aye.

Assessor Cermak presented the applications submitted by the organizations who had timely requested tax exemption. These forms certified that the use of the said property is for an exempt purpose by the applying organization. The Board approved the applications for exemption as submitted and as recommended by the Assessor.

Several Tax List Corrections were also presented by Assessor Cermak. Tax List Corrections #751 through 768 corrected the tax statements sent to those entities who are centrally assessed. The original statements incorrectly included a tax for an ESU #7 bond. A motion was made by Boss to approve all of the tax list corrections as presented. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye.
