Boss informed the other members of the Board that he had learned that the Village of Shelby had tested their tornado sirens in conjunction with the Shelby-Rising City Schools during Nebraska's Severe Weather Awareness Week. The two sheep foot rollers offered for sale via online auction have both been sold.
