The County Jail Report for the month of July was not presented for approval.

Milton Toy and Jack Carter, members of the Polk County Veterans Service Committee, were present with Kenneth Toline to discuss the vacant Veterans Service Officer position. The members of the Veterans Service Committee reported to the Board that Mr. Toline was the applicant for the position the Committee was appointing as Polk County Veterans' Service Officer and asked for the Board's confirmation as required by statute. A motion was made by Boruch to confirm the appointment of Kenneth D. Toline as Polk County Veterans Service Officer, subject to the certification of eligibility by the Nebraska Director of Veterans Affairs. The motion was seconded by Boss and the roll call vote was Boruch, aye; Boss, aye; Westring, aye. The veterans present also discussed the need for updated computer equipment for the office to access the State's programs and veteran database. Fellow veteran Dick Treadway was also present during the discussion.

At 10:00 a.m., a motion was made by Boss to open the hearing on the conditional use permit for Tax Lot C in the NW ¼ of Section 21, Township 16 North, Range 1 West as advertised. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boss, aye. Also present were Roland Johnson, representing the applicant Johnson Sand and Gravel, Bob Hegi and Dan Martensen. Mr. Johnson stated that he plans to excavate gravel on this parcel, much like he has done on other tracts in the area. The property is currently rented by a local farmer and the actual process of pumping the gravel may not occur for several years. Mr. Hegi had concerns regarding the boundary between his property and the subject property. The use of the sand pit created during the pumping process after the excavating ceases was an area of concern for Mr. Martensen. The Board informed him that the use of the property at that time would require another conditional use permitting process. At 10:15 a.m., a motion was made by Boss to close the hearing. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye. Chairman Westring stated the Planning Commission had recommended approval of the permit as the evidence presented at the Planning Commission's hearing satisfactorily met the seven requirements outlined in the zoning regulations for conditional use permits. A motion was made by Westring to approve the conditional use permit to operate a gravel pit in Tax Lot C located in the NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 16 North, Range 1 West. The motion was seconded by Boruch and the roll call vote was Westring, aye; Boruch, aye; Boss, aye.

Health Department Director Darla Winslow discussed the progress of the remodeling of the former Yungdahl's Apothecary building in Stromsburg. BTS has been contacted regarding installing the phone system and quotes are being obtained for the office furniture that will be needed. A moving plan will be developed once a delivery date has been set for the furniture.

A motion was made by Boss declaring the 1994 Ford F155 pickup as surplus property and authorizing it to be sold at the Osceola FFA Alumni consignment auction. The motion was seconded by Boruch and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Boruch, aye; Westring, aye.

Highway Supt. Theis also updated the Board on the work being done in the Road Dept. The rain yesterday morning left most county roads a mess. More clay will be hauled to the storage building across the street from the hospital and some crushed concrete may be placed there as well. One bid has been received for the scrap tire collection grant application. At least three bids are required to be submitted with the application.
