The County Jail Report for the month of August was reviewed by the Board and approved.

A motion was made by Boruch to approve the law enforcement contract with the Village of Shelby. The motion was seconded by Boss and the roll call vote was Boruch, aye; Boss, aye; Westring, aye. The three year contract runs from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2027.

The Board approved the closing of the Polk County Attorney Trust bank account at Pinnacle Bank in Osceola. The account has been dormant since June of 2020 and is no longer needed.

The annual inventory of the County Attorney was reviewed by the Board and approved.

A motion was made by Boss authorizing the Chairman to sign the amended and restated interlocal agreement for the formation of Region V Community Human Services Program and Region 5 Systems. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye.

A motion was made by Boss authorizing the Chairman to sign the amended and restated interlocal agreement for the formation of Region V Community Human Services Program and Apace. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye. The purpose of both interlocal agreements was to create separate interlocal agreements for both entities of the Region V Community Human Services Program.

The request of the Veterans Service Committee to hire clerical help for the Veterans Service Officer was discussed. A motion was made by Boss to allow the Veterans Service Officer to hire part time help to work 20 hours per week. The number of hours worked per week will be reviewed at a later date to see if adjustments are needed. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye.

McKinnis Roofing has discovered problems near the corner drains on the roof that need to be repaired and those repairs were not included in the original specifications and bids. A motion was made by Boss authorizing McKinnis to make the additional repairs to the courthouse roof. The motion was seconded by Westring and the roll call vote was Boss, aye; Westring, aye; Boruch, aye.

The County budget was reviewed and the budget hearing for the 2024-2025 County Budget will be held on September 24th, 2024, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

The general assistance applicant did not keep their scheduled appointment with the Board.

A motion was made by Boruch to adopt a resolution authorizing the Chairman to sign the LPA Program Agreement with the State of Nebraska, Department of Transportation for the Shelby North Bridge Project No: BRO-7072(17). The Federal share of the project will be up to 100% of the eligible costs. The motion was seconded by Boss and the roll call vote was Boruch, aye; Boss, aye; Westring, aye.

Highway Supt. Theis also updated the Board on the work being done in the Road Dept. The pavement is now done on the D Road project near the county line and ties into York County's hard surfaced D road. A motor grader that had warranty work done is back in service, a hydraulic hose has been replaced on the excavator, and repairs were made to the semi. The bridge over Clear Creek on 141st Road has also been repaired. Culverts are ready to be installed in three areas in the northeast portion of the county. Updated bus routes have only been received from one of the county schools.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 11:45 a.m. to meet again on September 24^h and October 1st, 2024. An agenda of the meetings will be available at the office of the County Clerk.
